Here is a recipe of one of my favourites, sitting in front of a fire on a cold night munching on Nuts and Bolts.

2 1/2 cups of Nutri-grain 2 1/2 cups unsalted mixed nuts 35g packet French Onion soup 1 tbsp Lemon Pepper. 1/3 cup Olive Oil.

#### Method.

Preheat oven to 180c. Line a large baking tray with baking paper.

Combine cereal, nuts, soup mix, lemon pepper, and oil in a large mixing bowl. Toss well to coat. Spread over prepared baking tray. Bake 15 minutes stirring every 5 mins or until hot and crisp. Set aside to cool completely. Store in an airtight jar.
