.....Explaining Club nights & Special Ticketed Events

There seems to be some confusion on the procedure for seating at Club Nights and Special Ticketed Events.

For normal Club nights, most attendees tend to sit at the same table each fortnight. The Committee are looking at ways to identify full tables, e.g. red balloons, to minimize embarrassment if turning away others who wish to sit there. If you regularly have more than 2 people at your table, you should contact Shirley on 0458 095 746 (or your Table Captain) to confirm seating. Please note, it may not be possible to sit at your usual table if you are bringing friends/relatives/new partners. Shirley or your Table Captain can confirm whether there is room at your table on a night-by-night basis. Club nights are not paid in advance.

Special Ticketed Events are completely different. You need to put your name down with Vicki on 0412 986 442 to reserve your tickets. You cannot just turn up on the night expecting a seat, as our special events are extremely popular. Tables are sold on a first come-first served basis, so get your name down quick! You can't assume that there is a ticket held for you because you always attend. Unfortunately, if you are bringing extra guests on the night, you may not be able to sit at your usual table. Special Ticketed Events require payment upfront and are non-refundable. If the event is a sell out and a waiting list exists, we can possibly help you to re-sell your tickets.

You may have new people sitting at your table at special events. It goes without saying that Legends is an inclusive, friendly club and we know that members will always make these new people feel welcome.

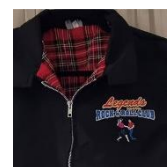

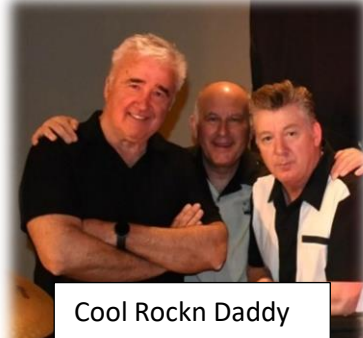
